POND REPAIRS IN KC

A residential stormwater detention pond, Kings Meade Pond 2, is located at the intersection of Eden Brook Drive and Copperwood Way. The existing 21-inch diameter corrugated metal pipe that conveys stormwater from the pond has started to corrode and repairs are needed. This capital project will slipline this pipe to protect the pipe, construct a new concrete riser structure to control flows from the pond, and construct an emergency spillway. The sidewalk along Eden Brook Drive adjacent to the pond will be closed during construction. Construction is anticipated to start in September 2018 and should be completed by the end of January 2019.
