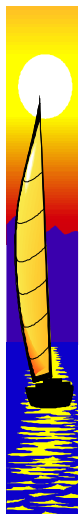

## NEW TRASH SCHEDULE

Effective Memorial Day 2009, Howard County will implement a new "slide" schedule for trash, recycling and yard waste collection on the six major holidays: Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day. The "slide" schedule means that when one of the above major holidays falls on a weekday (Monday-Friday), ALL trash, recycling and yardwaste collection scheduled on or after the holiday that week will "slide" one day.

## BEAUTIFY YOUR CUL-DE SAC

Kings Contrivance Community Association now has grants available for those of you wishing to perk up the look of your cul-de-sac. The grants reimburse up to \$200 for any approved plantings. All you supply is the plan and the work. You are free to choose any plants you like, but plans must be approved by the County in advance. Fill out a grant form at Amherst House and within two weeks bring the following information: a picture of the cul-de-sac as is, a petition signed by 80% of the residents of the street indicating no objection to your plans, and a plan for the beautification showing the location and list of specific plantings. Once your plan has been approved, you may begin work. Only 2 grants available this year...first come, first served!
